To be considered to take part in Council's Artist of the Month Exhibition Program you are required to complete and sign the EOI attached and provide all necessary information.

Eligibility

 You need to live, work or study in the Camden Local Government Area or Macarthur region.

Artist Responsibility

- Artists are responsible for delivery, installation/hanging and pick up of all works.
- Please provide an A5 list with artist bio and one line describing each work, the price, medium etc (double sided if required) to be available for the general public to take during the exhibition period. Council can provide photocopying (only applicable if you have been selected to exhibit).
- A media release will be sent out by the Council please provide
 the appropriate information. You may also be required to come in
 for a photo opportunity if requested by the media. It is at the media
 discretion as to whether the story is published in the newspaper.

Artworks

- Five images, either photographs or images on CD that are representative of your work will need to be provided with your completed application.
- All works are required to be suitably framed for hanging, framed with D-hooks, preferably, and wire. All gallery spaces have the same hanging system which uses wire and hooks.
- · Artist to provide own frames.
- Exhibits need to adhere to the exhibition spaces available and hung on the tracking provided. No blu tak is permitted on walls.

Works for Sale

- Contact needs to be made directly between the artist and the potential buyer. Council or library staff will not assist in the sales transaction.
- No commissions or fees are required from the artist if exhibiting at Camden Library or Narellan Library.

Bookings

- · All works are displayed for a period of one month.
- Exhibits are planned well in advance. Bookings are made six months ahead and are ongoing.
- It may be in your interest to take a self guided tour of our exhibition spaces prior to submitting your application.
- A specific day will be allocated for delivery and installation. Another for taking down your artworks (within Library operating hours).
- Please note Council staff reserves the right to change your Artist
 of the Month booking dates, with notification, to accommodate
 travelling exhibitions and Council related exhibitions.
